

Forms Required

APPLICATION TO TRAVEL and TRAVEL ROSTER—OUT OF STATE TOURNAMENTS ONLY

All AYSA Board of Directors or AYSA Office Staff are authorized to sign travel papers granting permission to travel. The travel papers must be signed prior to your departure for the event. Tournaments may have earlier deadlines for submitting your paperwork, please contact them for directions. If AYSA fees are due, they will be collected at the time the papers are signed. Fee schedule as follows:

National Teams: No charge

State Teams: \$25.00 per tournament

Club Teams: Must move to National or State Team to be eligible to travel out of state

Travel Application

Sections one and two (Application for Travel and Travel to a Tournament) are required for participation in all out of state tournaments. If you are traveling out of state to participate in "friendly" games, sections 1 and 3 (Application for Travel and Travel to participate in GAMES) are required.

Travel Roster

AYSA requires the top portion (team information) to be filled out. Player name, player ID number and Date of Birth are also required. We do not require the player signatures, year of graduation, jersey numbers or position. The tournament you are attending may require this information, please contact them for instructions.

If you need to add players to your roster after it has been signed, please keep the signed roster and draw a line through any players who will not be attending. Complete a new roster, with just the new player information, and resubmit both rosters for signature and verification. You will present both rosters during your check in at the tournament.

Loan Forms

Loan Forms for out of <u>state</u> tournaments must be completed and submitted for signature with the travel roster.

Loan forms are required for out of district tournaments, no other travel papers are needed.

Helpful Hints

Most tournaments require a copy of the player's birth documents for check in. You must have your medical releases notarized for out of state travel.
